

~ RIVER



#### Hidden gems along the journey

Your adventure begins with early morning pick-up from your hotel in Cusco for a scenic journey through the Andean highlands.

Our modern and comfortable tourist transportation will take you safely to your destination. The assigned driver has extensive knowledge of the route to the Hydroelectric plant and extensive experience traveling the roads in Peru.







Along the way, you'll pass through picturesque towns like Santa María and Santa Teresa, where the landscape shifts from rugged mountain views to lush jungle scenery.

You will arrive at Hydroelectric, the starting point of your independent hike to Aguas Calientes along the train tracks is a peaceful and safe route, surrounded by vibrant nature, rivers, and towering green mountains. Just be sure to follow safety signs and watch out for passing trains.

## RETURN

HYDROELECTRIC - CUSCO

#### Return to the Imperial City

After your visit to Machu Picchu (on your own schedule), begin your return by retracing your steps along the same beautiful path to Hydroelectric. Make sure to arrive 30 minutes before departure time at the same point you were dropped off the day before.

Our bus departures are only at 2:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m., so it's essential to plan ahead — there are no later buses that day.



With our service you will travel back to Cusco by the same route, enjoying the changing landscape one last time. While you rest in comfortable seats while our expert driver takes you back.

The arrival in Cusco will be at Plaza San Francisco, where you can head to your hotel or grab a late dinner at your leisure.

Do you have questions? We'll answer them here! In this section, we encourage you to read this information carefully, as it will also answer any questions you may have about our exclusive services.

- On the second day, the passenger must walk again from Aguas Calientes to Hydroelectric (13 km) to take the transport back to Cusco. The return also has an approximate duration of 6 hours.
- IS THE HIKE FROM HIDROELÉCTRICA TO AGUAS CALIENTES DIFFICULT?

The hike is 13 km (approximately 3 hours) and follows the train tracks. It's a flat, safe route surrounded by nature, but it's recommended to be alert for trains and follow safety signs.

## DO I NEED A GUIDE FOR THE HIKE TO AGUAS CALIENTES?

It's not mandatory. The route is direct and well-marked, so it can be done independently without any complications.

### WHAT TIME IS THE PICK-UP IN CUSCO AND HOW LONG IS THE TRIP TO HIDROELÉCTRICA?

Pickup is between 6:00 a.m. and 6:30 a.m. approx. from centrally located hotels in Cusco. The trip takes approximately 6 hours, depending on traffic and road conditions.

## WHAT IS THE RETURN TRIP TO CUSCO LIKE ON THE SECOND DAY?

On the second day, passengers must walk again from Aguas Calientes to Hidroeléctrica (13 km) to catch the return trip to Cusco. The return trip also takes approximately 6 hours.

## WHERE DO I SPEND THE NIGHT AND WHAT ARE THE DINING OPTIONS?

The night is spent in the town of Aguas Calientes, where there are various accommodation options, restaurants, and shops for dining and relaxing.








# WHATTO BRING?
