At the hotel, you can enjoy a delicious breakfast. After the breakfast you will also have time to rest before exploring the city of kings.

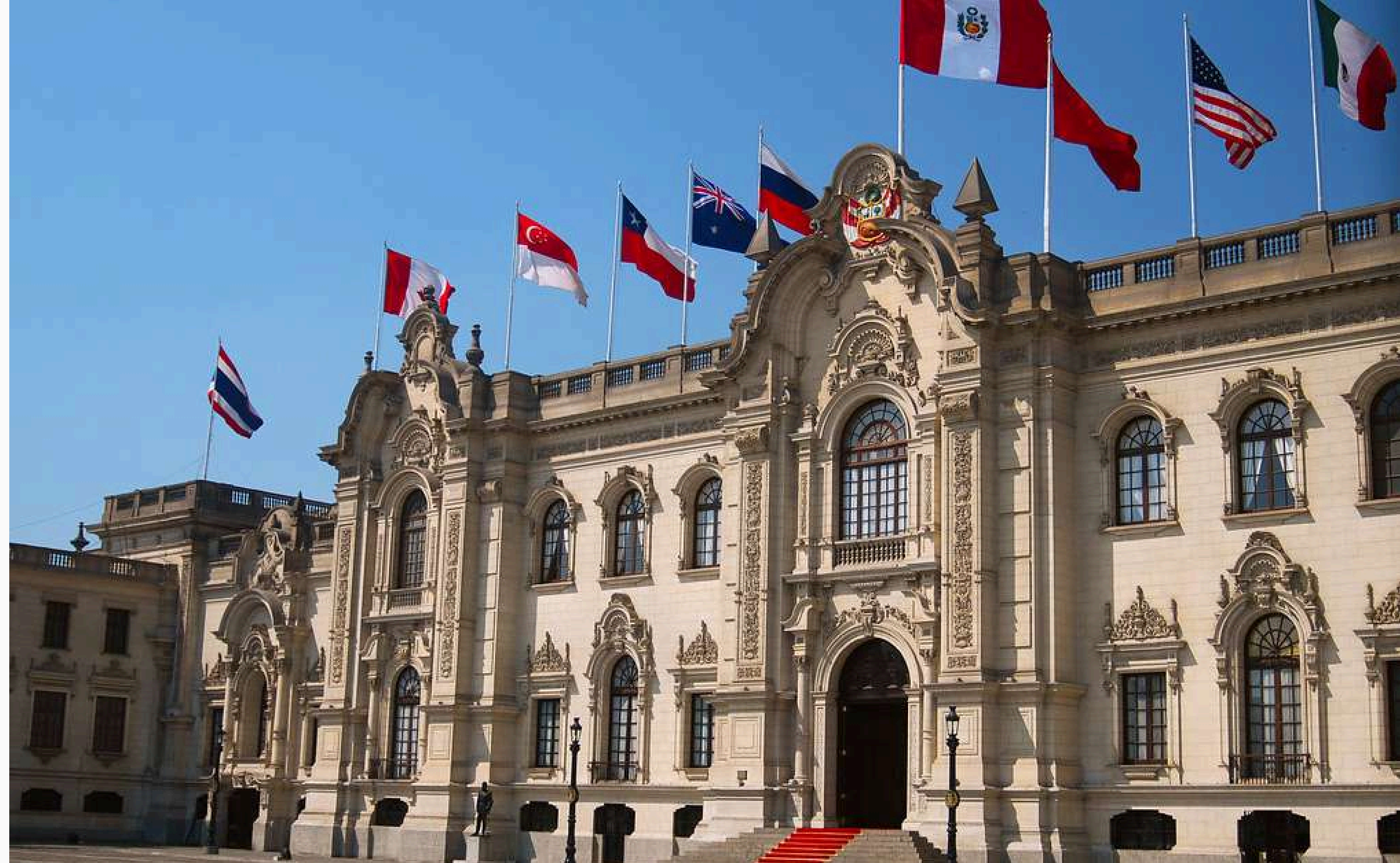
The day begins in Lima's Historic Center, where you'll visit a charming Franciscan monastery and a fascinating colonial mansion dating back to the mid-16th century, for a glimpse of colonial-era lifestyle.



Franciscan monastery, famous for its architecture and underground catacombs.

Then, watch the solemn changing of the guard at the Presidential Palace, as you stroll past Lima Cathedral and Plaza de Armas.

The tour continues along Jiron de la Unión boulevard. The Spanish Baroque architecture and bohemian streets will tell you the complex and interesting history of the capital.



The echo of the past resonates in its temples, filling those who visit it with history and knowledge.

Larco Museum

In the afternoon, you will visit Housed in an 18th-century colonial mansion in Lima, the Rafael Larco Herrera Archaeological Museum houses more than 45,000 pre-Columbian art objects, making it one of the most comprehensive collections in the world.

From bones from cultures such as Cupisnique, Nazca, Moche, Chimú, and Inca to gold jewelry you will also have the opportunity to appreciate textiles, and stunning ceramics, the museum offers a journey through more than 5,000 years of Peruvian history.

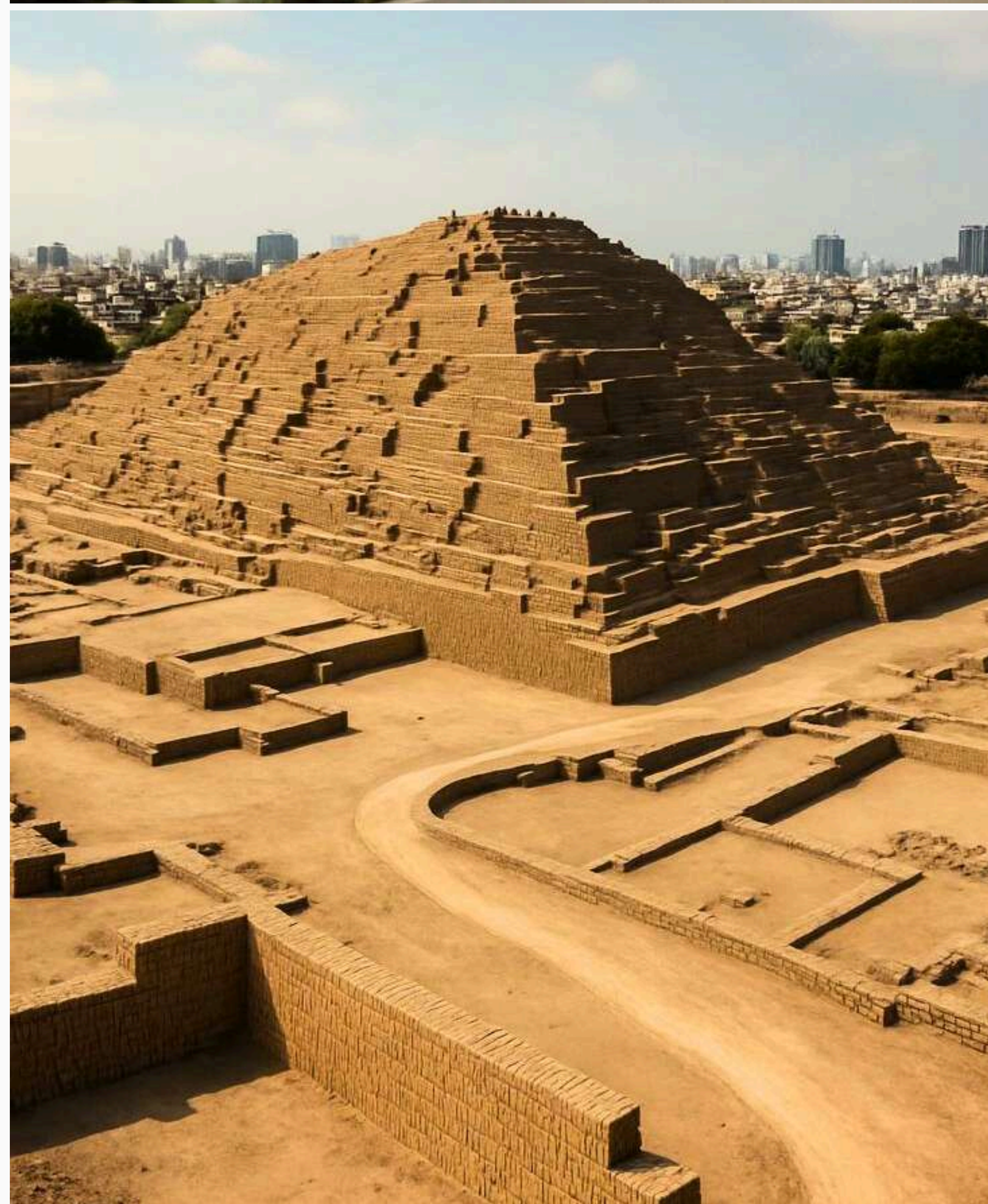

PISAC MARKET FOR LUNCH AT A HACIENDA
IN THE SACRED VALLEY

Tradition, Scenery, and Flavor in the Sacred Valley

This day takes you deep into the cultural and culinary heart of the Sacred Valley. Begin with a visit to Pisac, a picturesque town known for its vibrant artisan market, where you'll find handmade textiles, ceramics, and jewelry. Pisac is also near an archaeological complex with the same name, one of the most impressive examples of Inca engineering.



The archaeological remains of Pisac are strategically located; the ancient Incas controlled access to the Sacred Valley.

Later, head to a colonial hacienda and farm. A local family will welcome you into their home and let you come close to farm life in the valley by their side. You will learn firsthand about giant white corn, a crop native to the Sacred Valley (the only one in the world with a certificate of origin!), its harvest, and life at the ranch.

While you discover the traditions behind its cultivation you will enjoy a farm-to-table four-course lunch prepared with seasonal, organic and natural ingredients.

This immersive experience offers a beautiful blend of history, local life, and culinary heritage.

CHINCHERO- VIVIENTIAL EXPERIENCE WITH
LOCAL PEOPLE – SALINERAS – MORAY –
MARAS

Connect with Andean Roots in a Day Full of Flavor and Culture

Start your day with a delicious breakfast
before heading to the highland town of
Chinchoero.

In Chinchoero you will explore ancient Inca
ruins and learn about traditional Andean
textile. At the archaeological site, you'll
explore ancient walls and learn about
the town's importance during the Inca
Empire. You will visit a textile workshop to
see how old weaving ways are still used.
In this cultural town you'll witness the
ancestral wisdom of the women weavers
who still preserve ancient techniques of
natural dyeing and weaving.



The adventure continues to Machuqolqa, a place with a privileged view of the Sacred Valley where you will have the opportunity to try authentic “Pachamanca” prepared underground with hot stones.

The “Pachamanca” is an ancestral dish of Peruvian cuisine with profound cultural and spiritual significance, serving as a symbol of connection with Pachamama (Mother Earth). This ancestral dish it is traditionally prepared in a community due to its complex preparation and variety of ingredients. It is also prepared on special occasions.

While the meal is being cooked, enjoy walking among alpacas and soaking in the authentic atmosphere of rural Andean life.

Let Chinchero surprise you with its diversity, its rhythm and its Peruvian essence.



After an unforgettable culinary experience, you'll visit the Maras Salt Mines, where salt is still extracted using ancient techniques. Maras Salt Mines offer a visual spectacle: thousands of white pools gleaming in the sun, like a gift from the Apus. Here you will have the opportunity to learn how artisanal salt is made using techniques passed down from generation to generation. Used since pre-Inca times, these pools are still worked by local families who harvest salt by hand.

Moray will be the next destination. Visiting the impressive circular terraces of Moray, you'll experience the ingenuity and spirituality with which the Incas worked the land. You will see the round farm terraces carved into the earth. These concentric platforms likely served as a kind of open-air agricultural lab, where different temperatures and microclimates helped the Incas experiment with crops.

Built by the Inca Pachacutec in the 15th century, this fortress served as both a temple and a military bastion.



In the afternoon, you will board the modern Vistadome Observatory train to Aguas Calientes. Vistadome Observatory train is a luxury experience that will allow you to appreciate the beautiful landscapes of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. During the tour, you'll enjoy various artistic presentations and interpretations featuring traditional music, dance, and costumes.

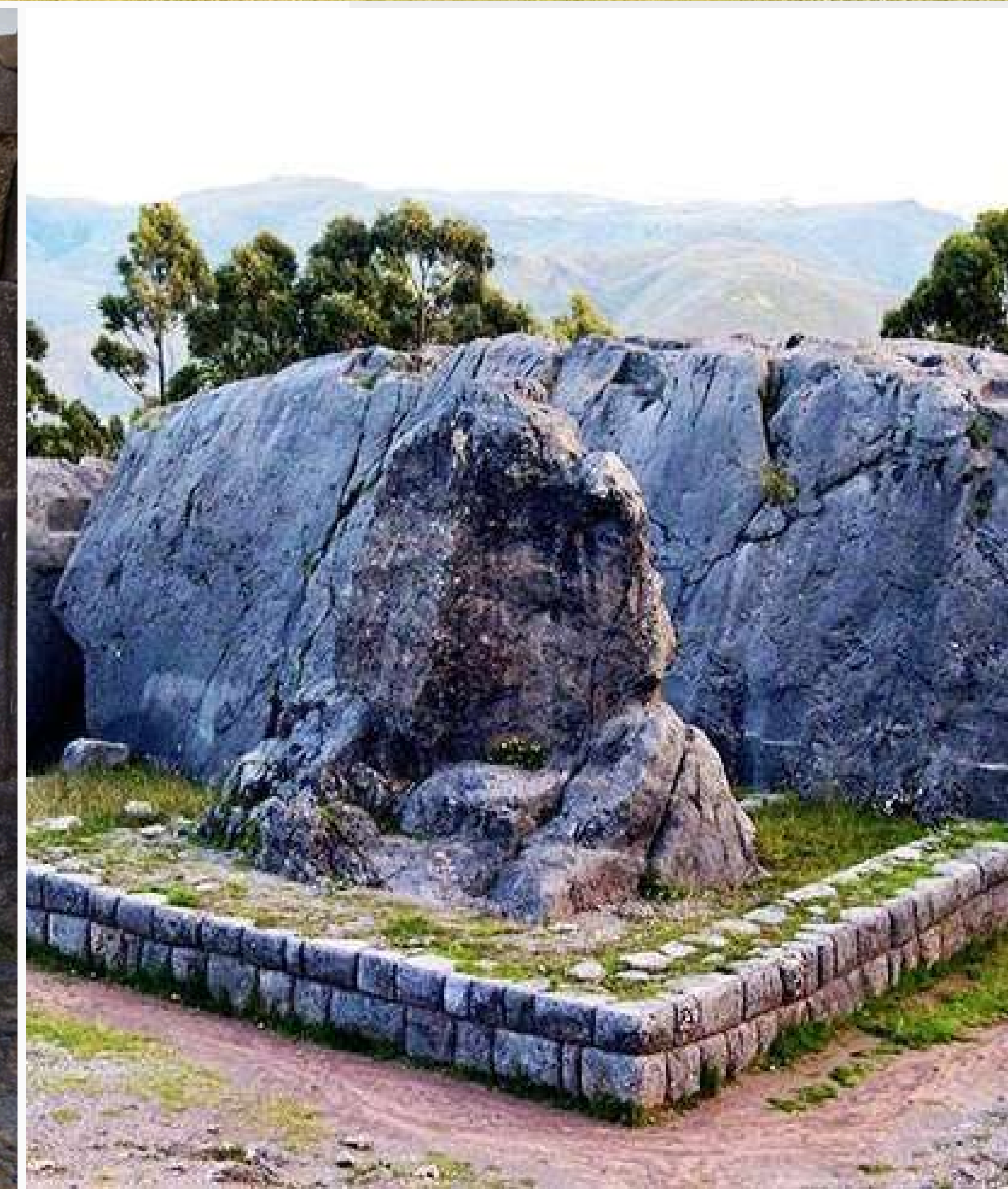

CUSCO CITY TOUR AND INCA RUINS

Explore the Inca Capital's Hidden Treasures

Spend your morning at leisure, perfect for adjusting to the altitude or exploring Cusco's coffee shops, artisan shops and museums.

In the afternoon, get ready to join a guided city tour starting with the Santo Domingo Convent, built atop the Inca Temple of the Sun (Qoricancha). Then, visit the city's surrounding archaeological sites: the monumental fortress of Sacsayhuaman, the sacred site of Q'enqo, the military ruins of Pukapukara, and the water temple of Tambomachay.



City tour in Cusco

The first destination will be the Convent of Santo Domingo, built on the foundations of the Qoricancha (Temple of the Sun). In ancient times, the Qoricancha was the most sacred sanctuary of the Inca Empire, where the perfectly assembled stone walls and ancient golden altars reveal the grandeur of a civilization that dominated the heavens and the earth.

The magic of Cusco transcends the city, as you'll discover impressive archaeological complexes such as Q'enqo, a mysterious ceremonial site carved into rock. Puka Pukara, the red fortress. Tambomachay, the ancient Inca baths, the name is associated with water worship and purification featuring impressive aqueducts and waterfalls that demonstrate advanced hydraulic engineering.



One of the most impressive places of this day is Sacsayhuamán, this colossal ceremonial fortress built with massive stone blocks that fit together perfectly without mortar. This site offers panoramic views of Cusco and hosts the annual Inti Raymi festival, a celebration of the sun. Even now it is difficult to replicate this kind of perfection that combines rocks and architecture.

You'll not only be able to taste these Andean delicacies but also you will learn about the products that form the basis of one of the world's most beloved cuisines.

Peruvian cuisine has been internationally recognized for its creativity, diversity, and ancestral roots, and the San Pedro Market is the perfect setting to understand its essence from its origins.

➤ **WHAT IS THE BEST TIME OF THE YEAR TO DO THIS TOUR?**

The best time is from April to October, during the dry season. However, the tour operates all year round. In the rainy season (November to March), some activities may be adjusted for safety.

➤ **WHAT EXACTLY DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE?**

The package includes transportation, specialized guides, equipment for the adventure activities, food during the tour, lodging and entrance to Machu Picchu. It may also include the train or bus back to Cusco, depending on the modality contracted

➤ **IS THERE A VEGETARIAN OPTION OR FOR SPECIAL DIETS?**

Yes, you just have to inform us in advance about your dietary needs (vegetarian, vegan, gluten free, etc.) and the team will take care of adapting your meals during the tour.

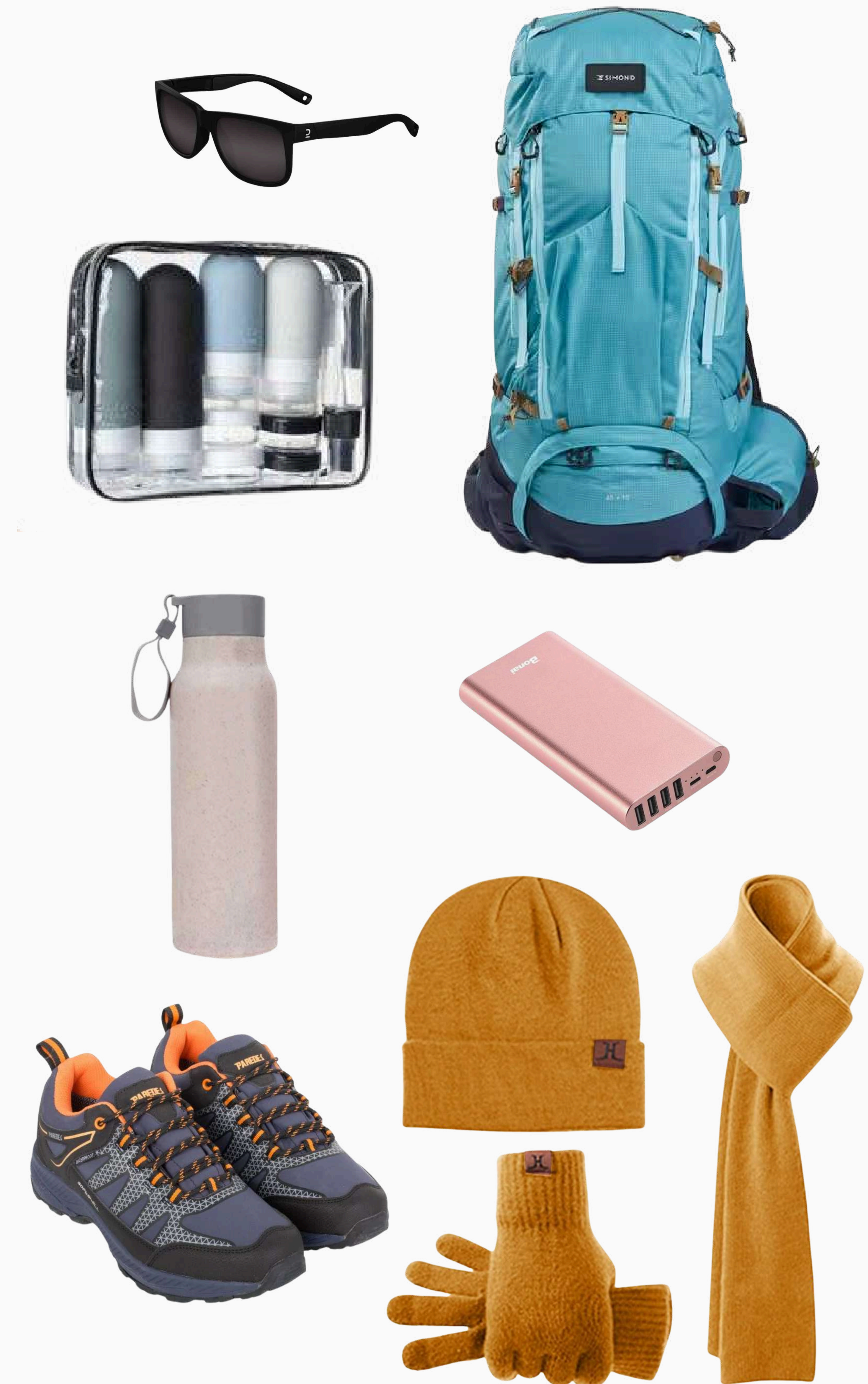
➤ **CAN I BOOK THIS TOUR PRIVATELY OR WITH A CLOSED GROUP?**
