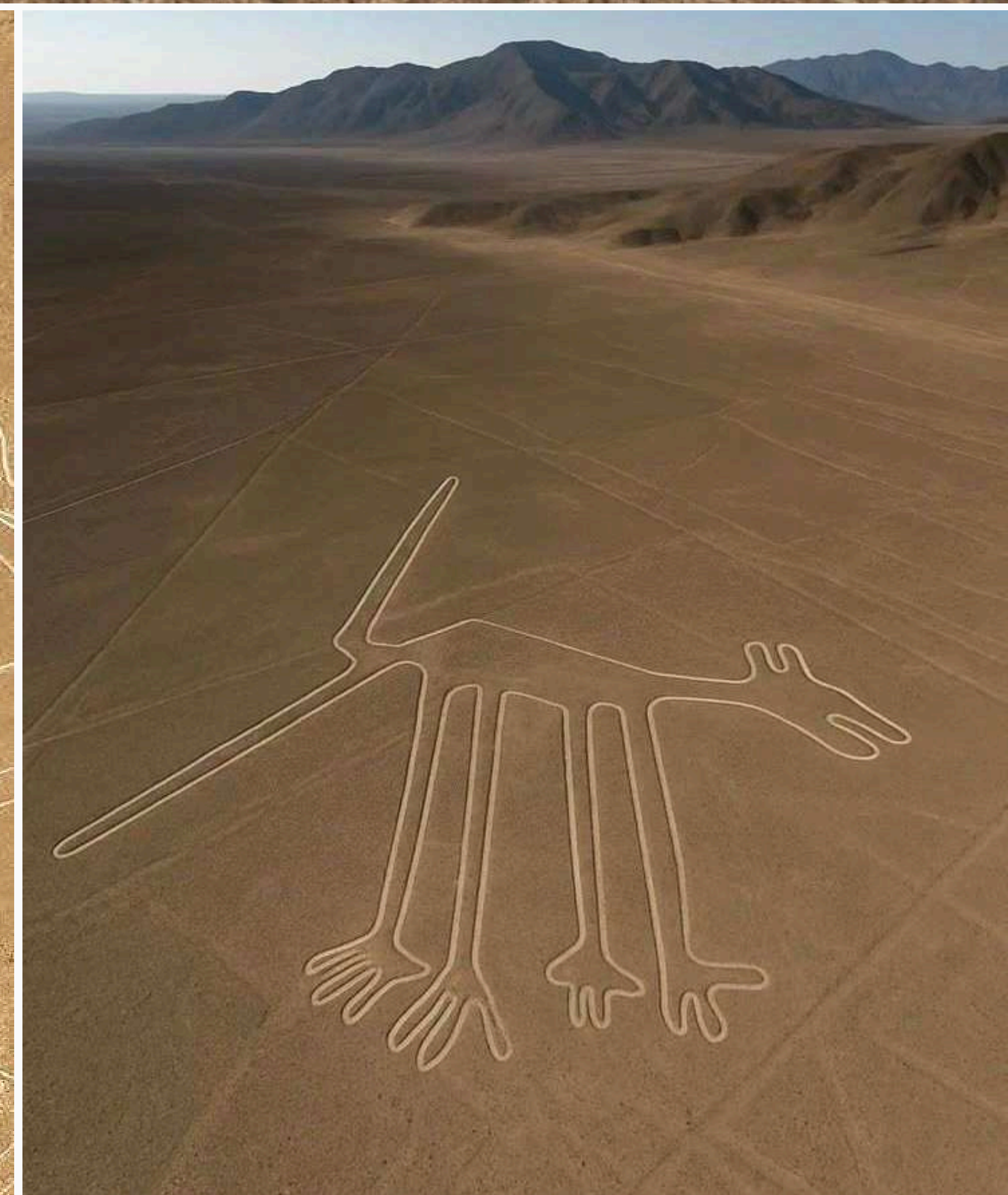
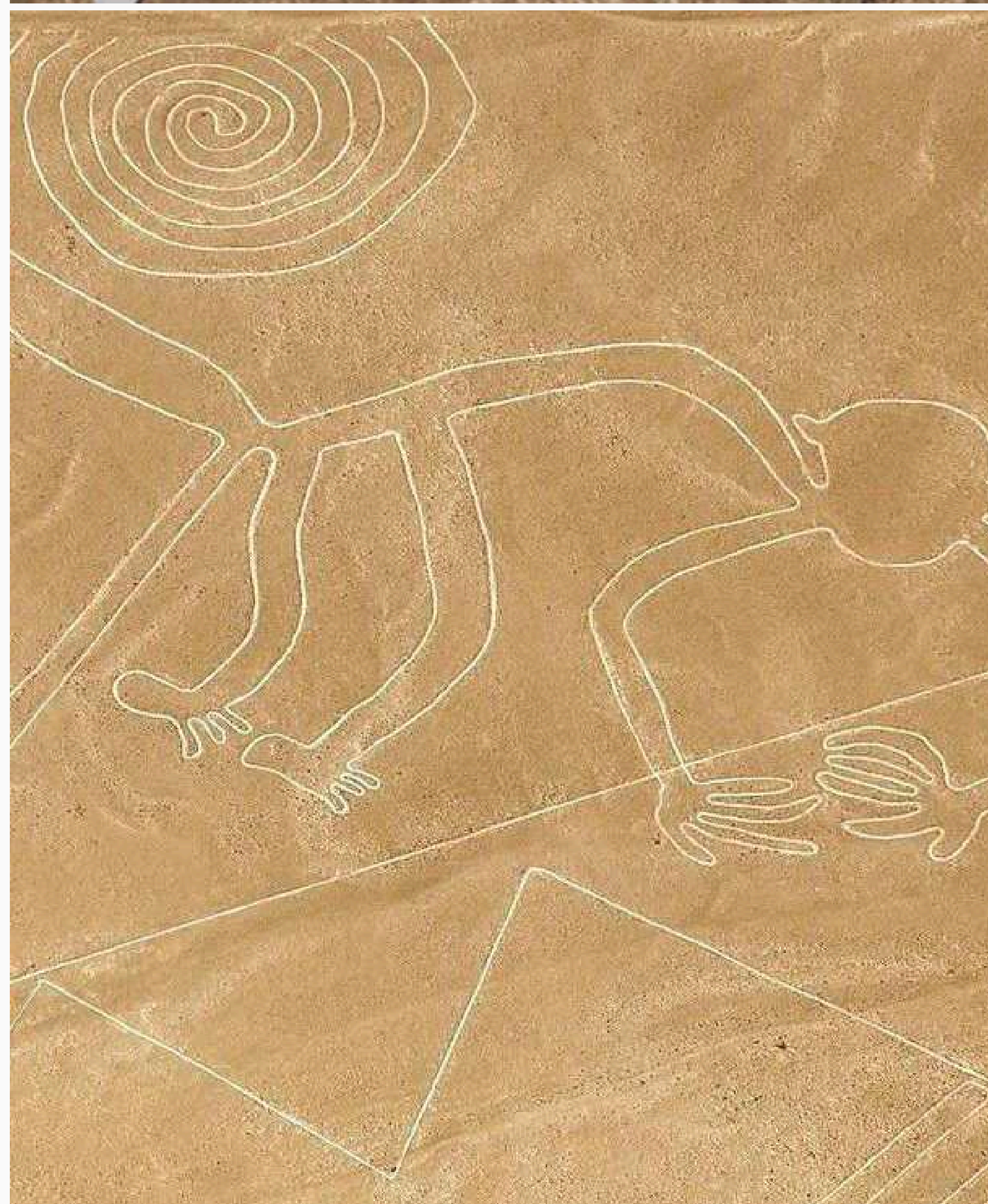
NAZCA - NAZCA LINES OVERFLIGHT - AREQUIPA

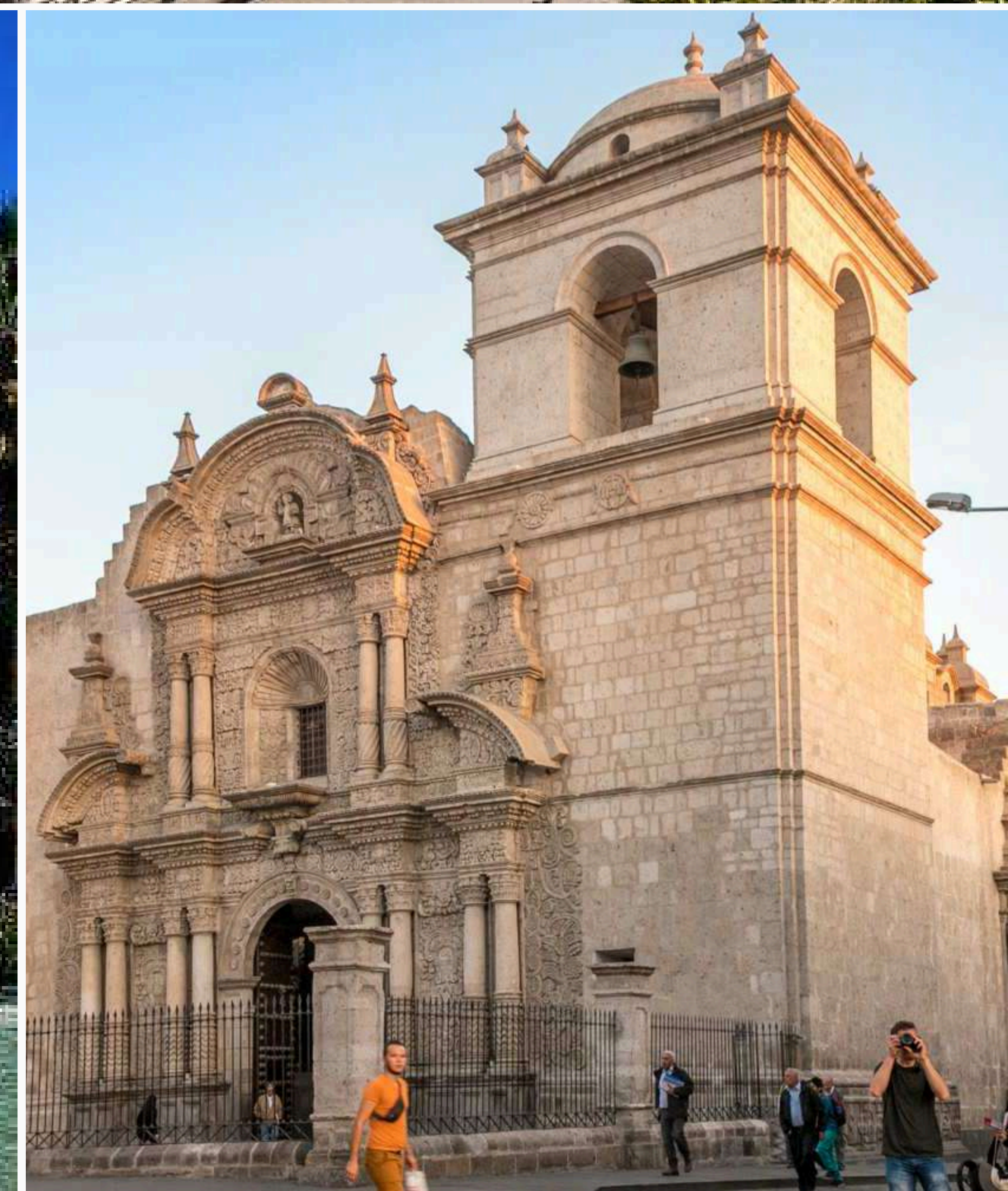
DAY 04

CITY TOUR DE AREQUIPA

The White City awaits your arrival

Arequipa is known as the "White City" because its colonial architecture uses sillar (a special type of volcanic stone).

On this tour, you will explore the heart of the city, the Plaza de Armas, surrounded by majestic architecture that tells the story of the city's historic past because this place is the founding site of the city. The construction of the Plaza de Armas began when the city was founded on August 15, 1540, by Garci Manuel de Carbajal in the Chili River valley as "Villa de la Asunción de Nuestra Señora del Valle Hermoso de Arequipa".



You will visit the Cathedral, an example of Spanish colonial architecture reflecting centuries of history, and the Iglesia de la Compañía, a masterpiece that combines Baroque and Mestizo styles, revealing Arequipa's cultural fusion.

You'll also visit the former Jesuit temple, a sanctuary filled with prayer and devotion, displaying intricate crafts and religious artifacts.

You'll have the opportunity to visit sacred and ceremonial sites.

The island is characterized by its friendly residents, who proudly maintain the traditional customs and dress of their ancestors, they will teach you about their traditional costumes, music and lifestyle. You will have the unique opportunity to spend the night on Amantaní in a family home surrounded by peace and nature.

The residents of the Uros consider themselves Lords of the Lake.

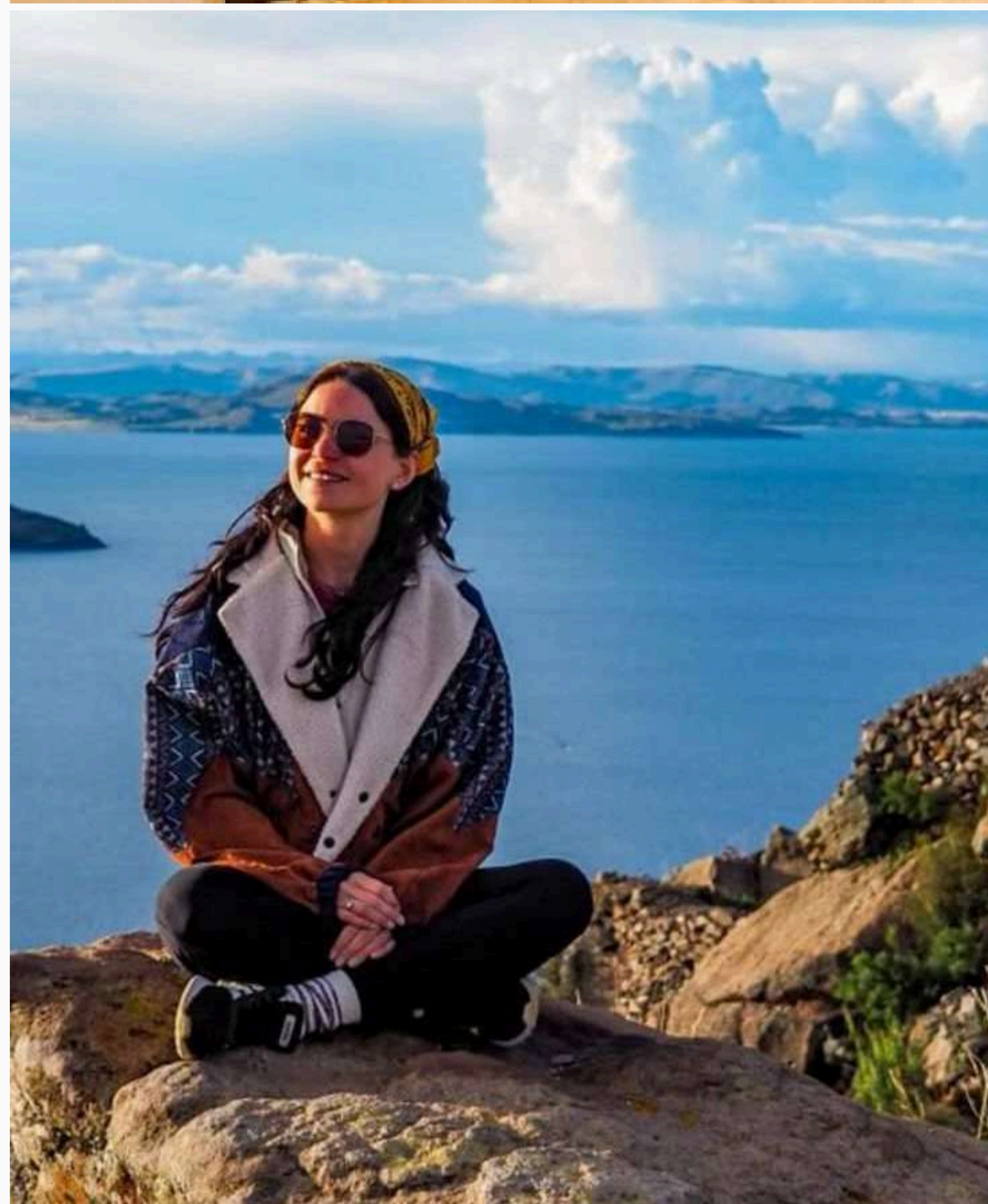

Taquile Island is renowned for its stunning natural and cultural beauty. It is currently recognized as an Intangible Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO.

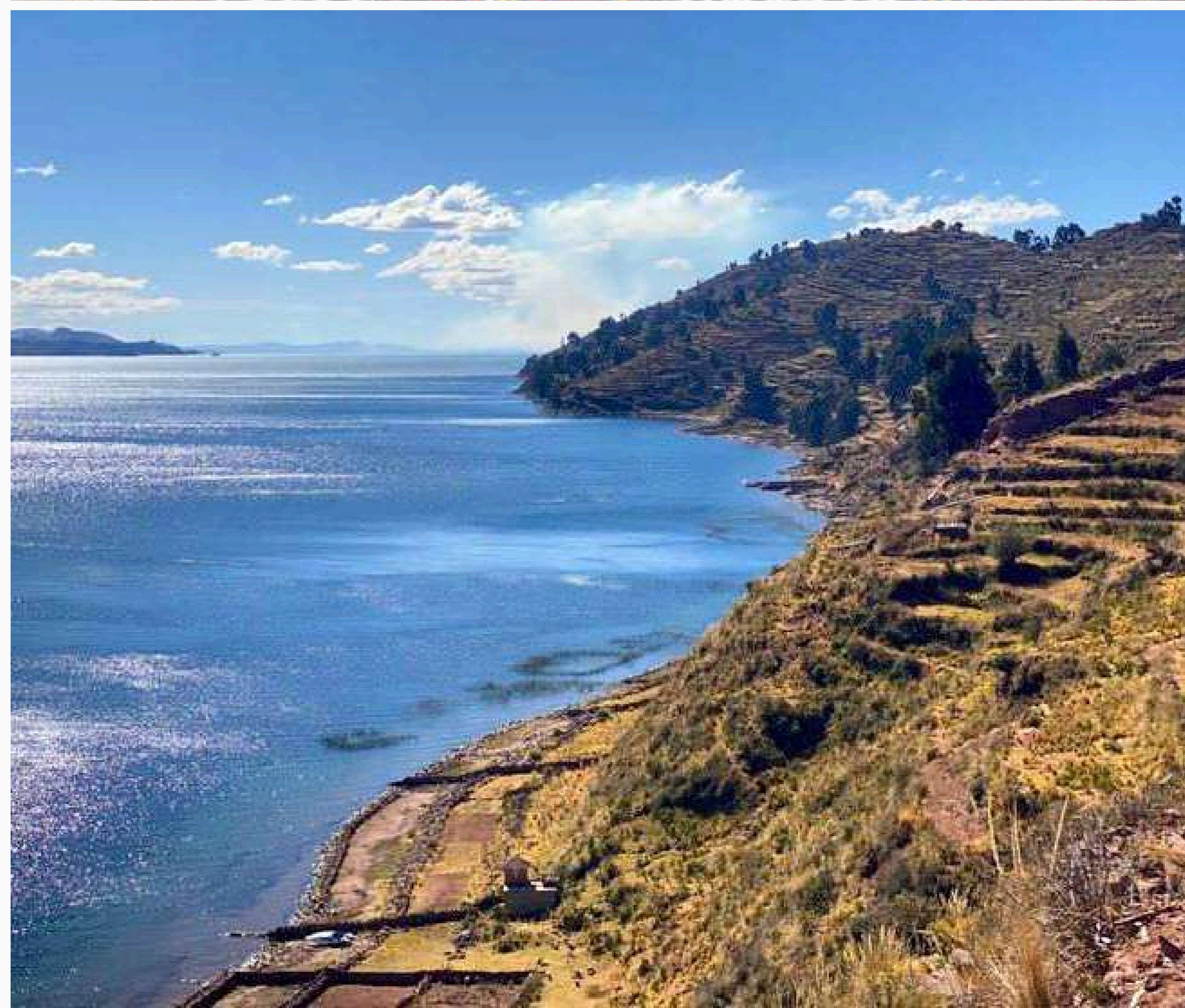

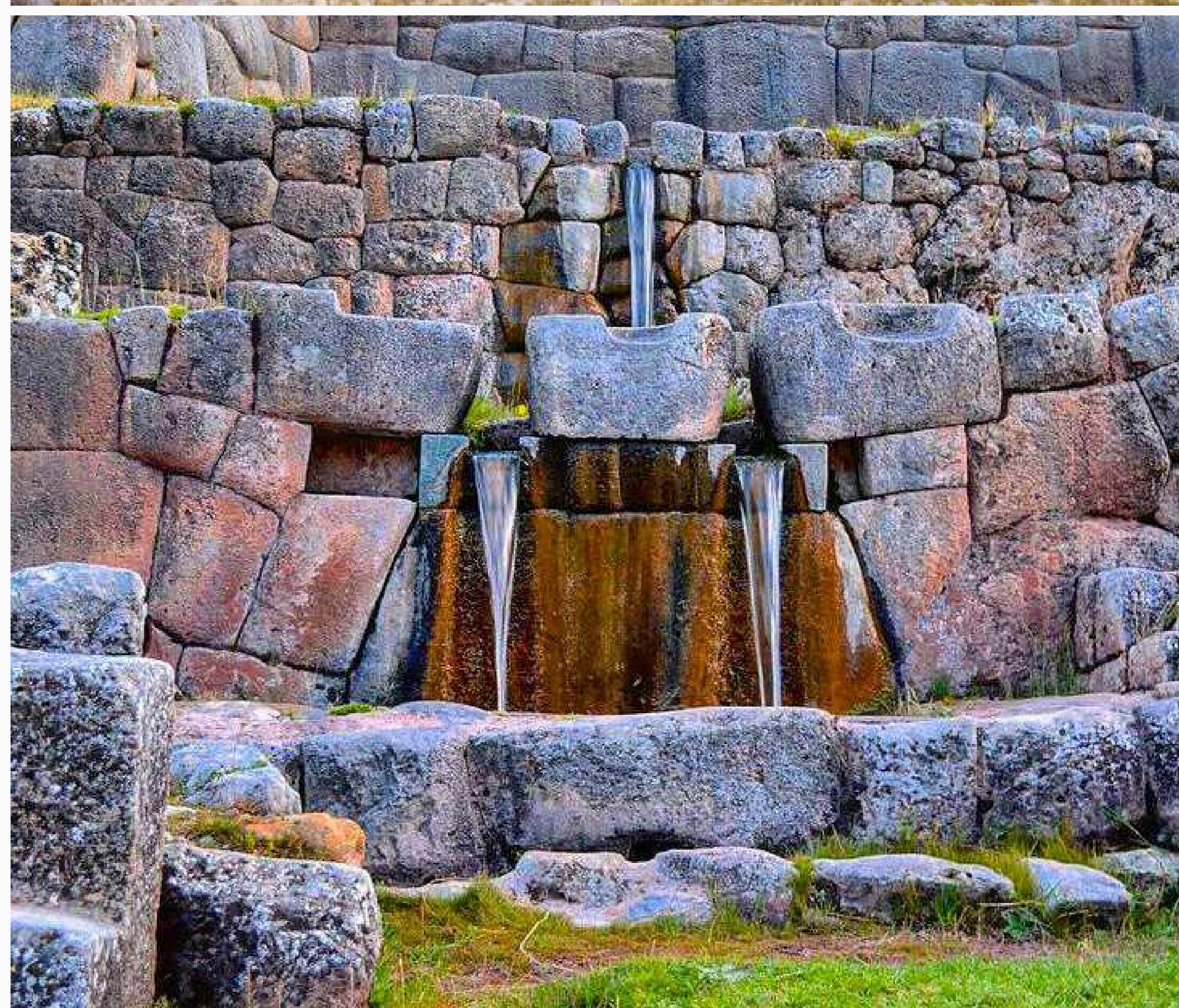
City tour in Cusco

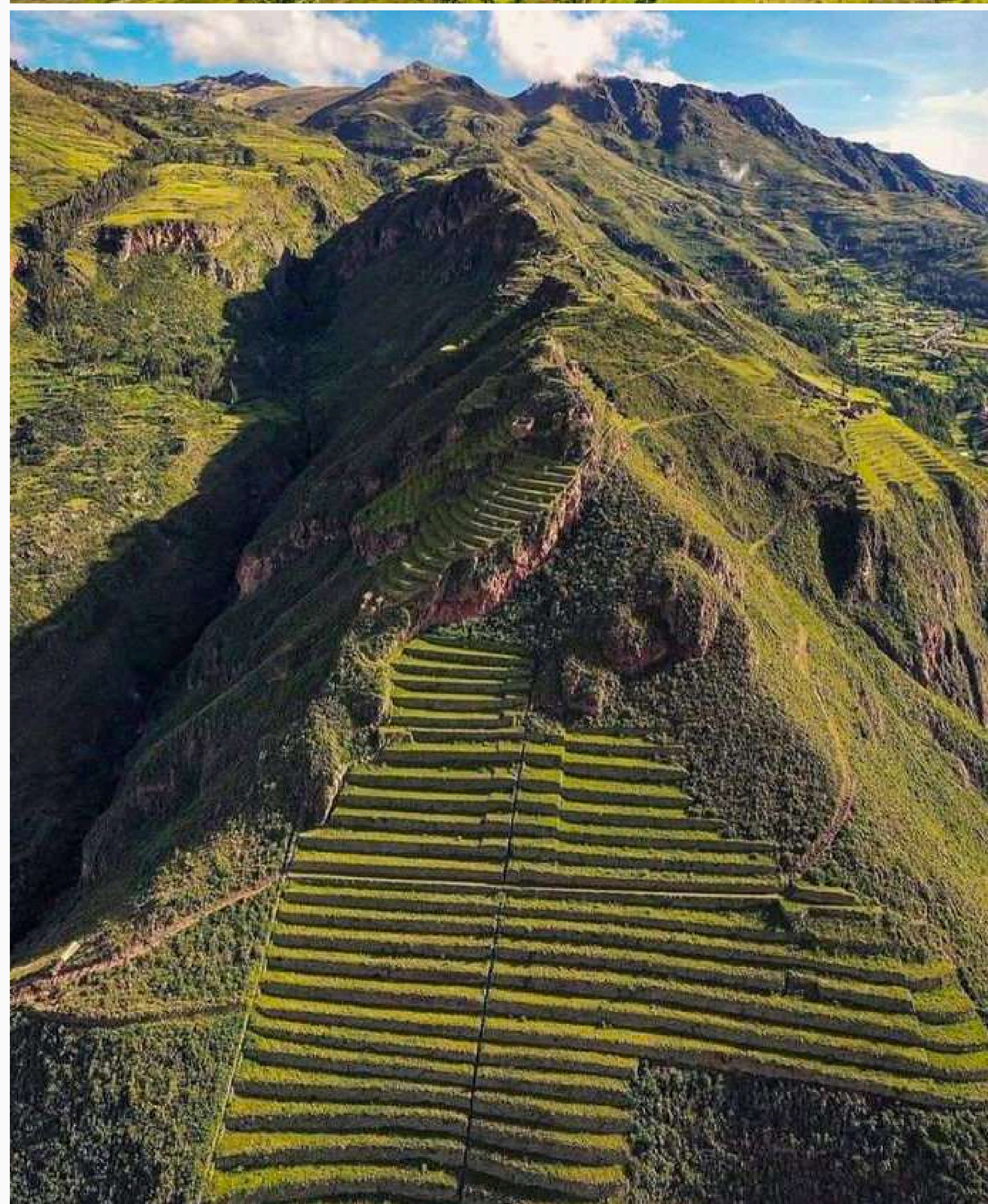

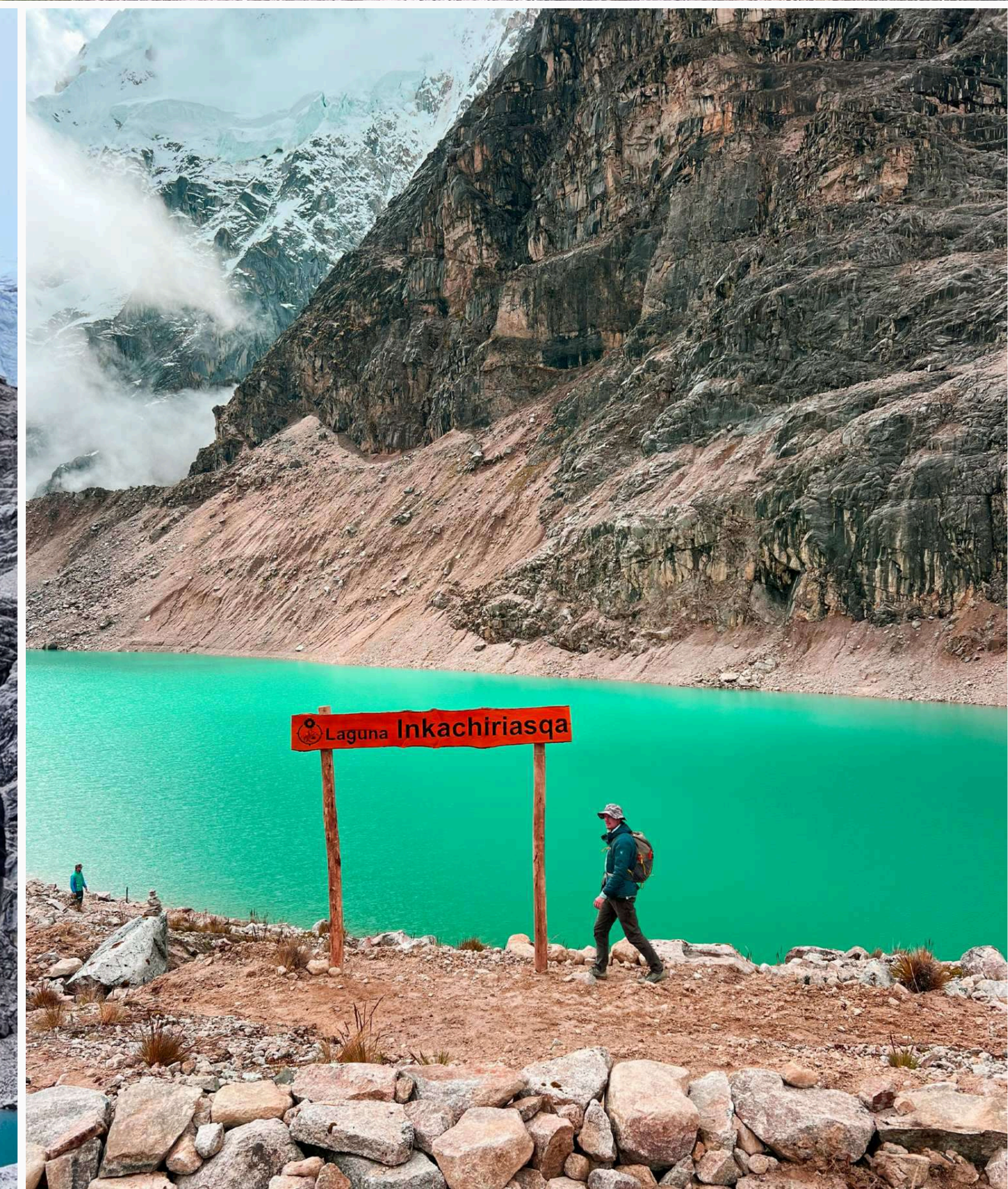

In the evening, we'll enjoy a comforting dinner before settling in for the night in our glamping tents, under the stars in the shadow of the Salkantay. A truly magical way to end the day in the heart of the Andes.

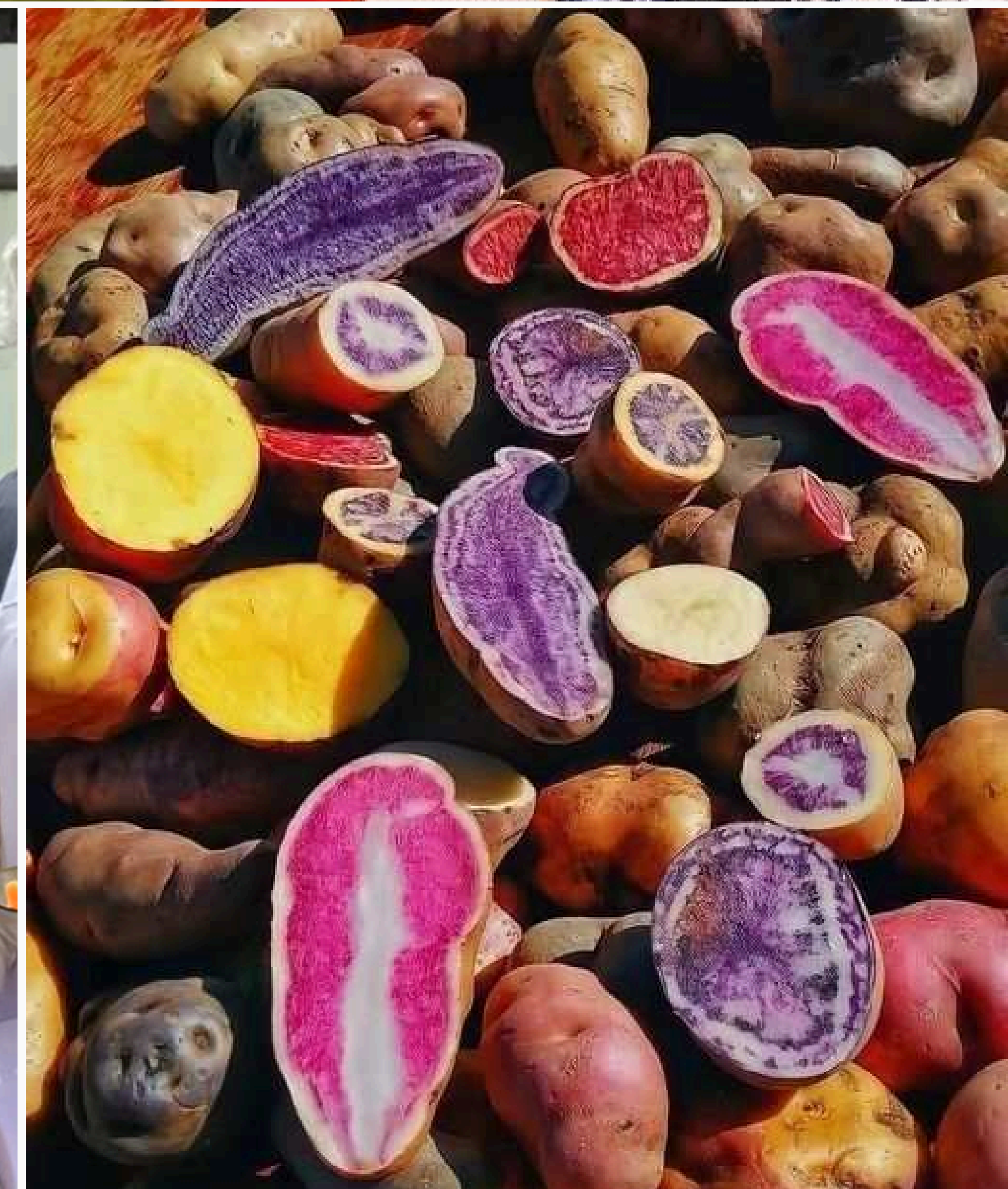

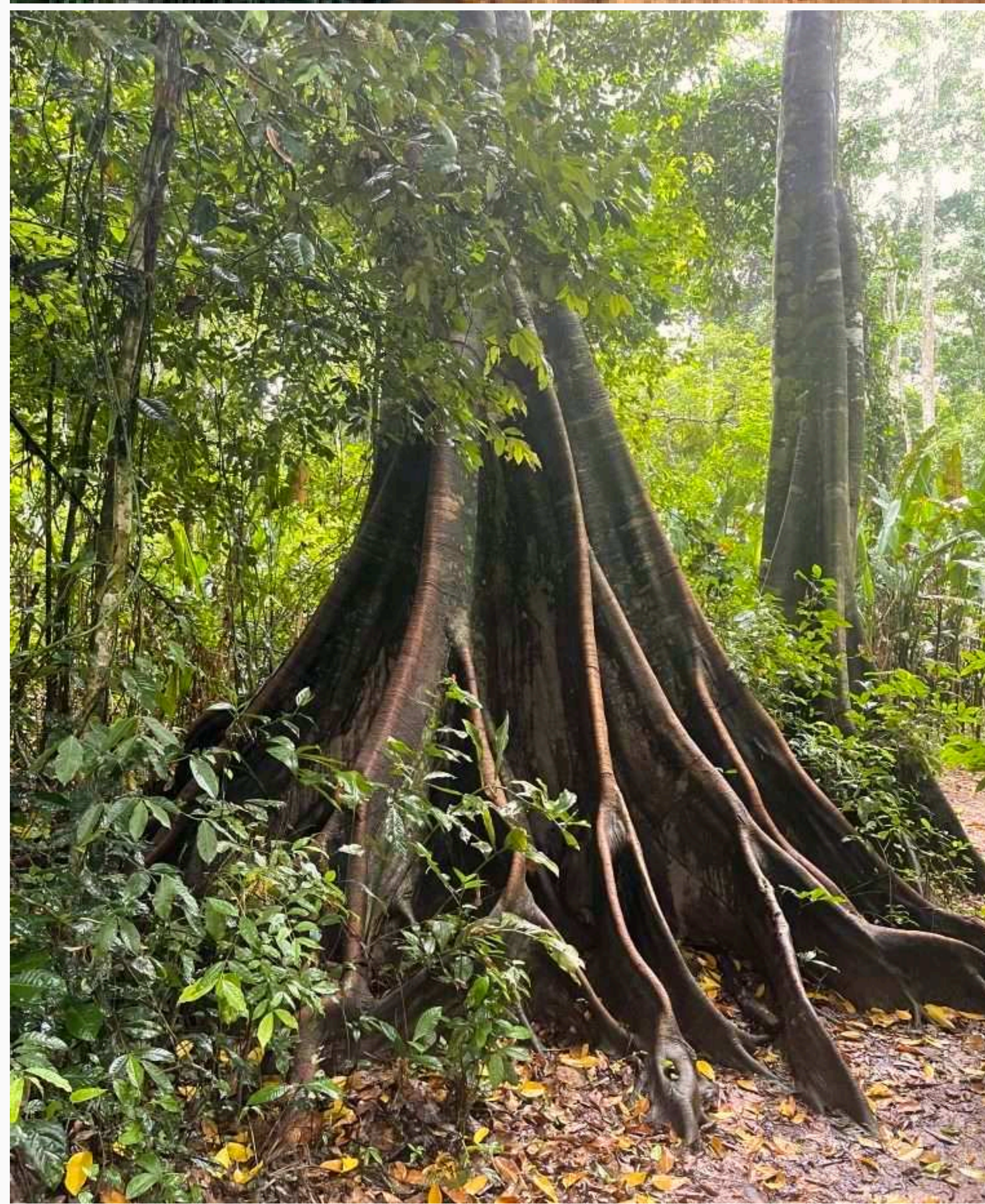

Early in the morning you will board a boat for a 1.5 hour approximately to the Chuncho Macaw Clay Lick, surrounded by lush nature and breathtaking scenery. Upon arrival at the clay lick, you'll enjoy a delicious breakfast with the best local fruits on site while waiting for the arrival of parrots and macaws, who come to feed on the mineral-rich clay. It's an unforgettable and colorful sight as the sky fills with color and sound.



By mid-morning, you will return to the lodge for a rest and time to relax. For those who wish may take a dip in the Tambopata River or try their luck fishing—there are over 250 species of fish in the area!

After lunch, an ethnobotanical walk along the trails of Tambopata will be the best option! Can you imagine a better place to learn about medicinal plants and trees used by local communities? In this day you will discover fascinating species such as walking palms, centuries-old lupuna trees, hollow giants, and more.

As night falls, a nocturnal boat excursion in search of caimans will make you feel the beauty of the night. This is the best time to spot them, as their eyes reflect light in the dark.

The biodiversity here is overwhelming: from macaws to monkeys.

It's a perfect transition from the Andes to the Amazon.

After the breakfast, the adventure will start with our kayaking; before this activity the guide will provide a brief orientation and basic paddling instruction.



The excursion is conducted downstream along the Tambopata River, accompanied by a support motorboat that follows at a safe distance for assistance. This calm and scenic journey offers great opportunities to spot birds and wildlife along the riverbanks.

We'll reach a natural beach, where there will be time for a refreshing swim in the river, surrounded by the pristine Amazon environment. Afterwards, we'll return to the lodge to enjoy a relaxing lunch.

In the afternoon, after a short rest, we'll head out on a brief jungle walk leading to the Amazon Adventure Park, where you'll take part in fun treetop activities. Test your agility and courage with zip lines, hanging bridges, ropes, and other canopy challenges, all under the supervision of trained staff and surrounded by the lush rainforest.

➤ **WHAT KIND OF WEATHER SHOULD I EXPECT DURING THE TRIP?**

Peru has multiple microclimates. In Lima, the climate is temperate and humid; in Ica, it's dry and hot; in Arequipa and Cusco, it's cool during the day and cold at night; in Puno, temperatures can be very cold in the early morning; and in Puerto Maldonado, it's tropical and humid. We recommend layered clothing.



➤ **WHAT MEASURES ARE TAKEN TO ACCLIMATE TO THE HIGH ALTITUDE IN DESTINATIONS LIKE CUSCO AND PUNO?**

The route is designed for a gradual ascent. We also offer recommendations and rest time to avoid altitude sickness, as well as coca tea and oxygen if necessary.

➤ **WHAT TYPE OF ACCOMMODATION IS INCLUDED DURING THE TRIP?**

We include carefully selected hotels in the Superior or Superior tourist category (3-star and 4-star), with breakfast included. In Puerto Maldonado and Andean communities, overnight stays are provided in lodges or local homes with comfortable and safe services.

Yes, of course. It includes the tourist train (Vistadome or similar), bus transfer, official entrance ticket, and a guided visit led by a local expert. You'll also have free time to explore the site on your own.

➤ ARE ANY VACCINATIONS REQUIRED TO ENTER THE JUNGLE OR OTHER DESTINATIONS ON THE TRIP?

No vaccinations are required for entry to Peru. However, for jungle areas like Puerto Maldonado, the yellow fever vaccination and the use of insect repellent to prevent insect bites are recommended.

➤ ARE CULINARY EXPERIENCES INCLUDED IN THE TOUR?

Absolutely! The tour features several culinary highlights, including lunch at local haciendas, traditional dinners, visits to local markets, and tastings at top restaurants in Lima, Arequipa, Cusco, and the Sacred Valley.

Yes, all internal flights mentioned in the itinerary are included, along with airport transfers.

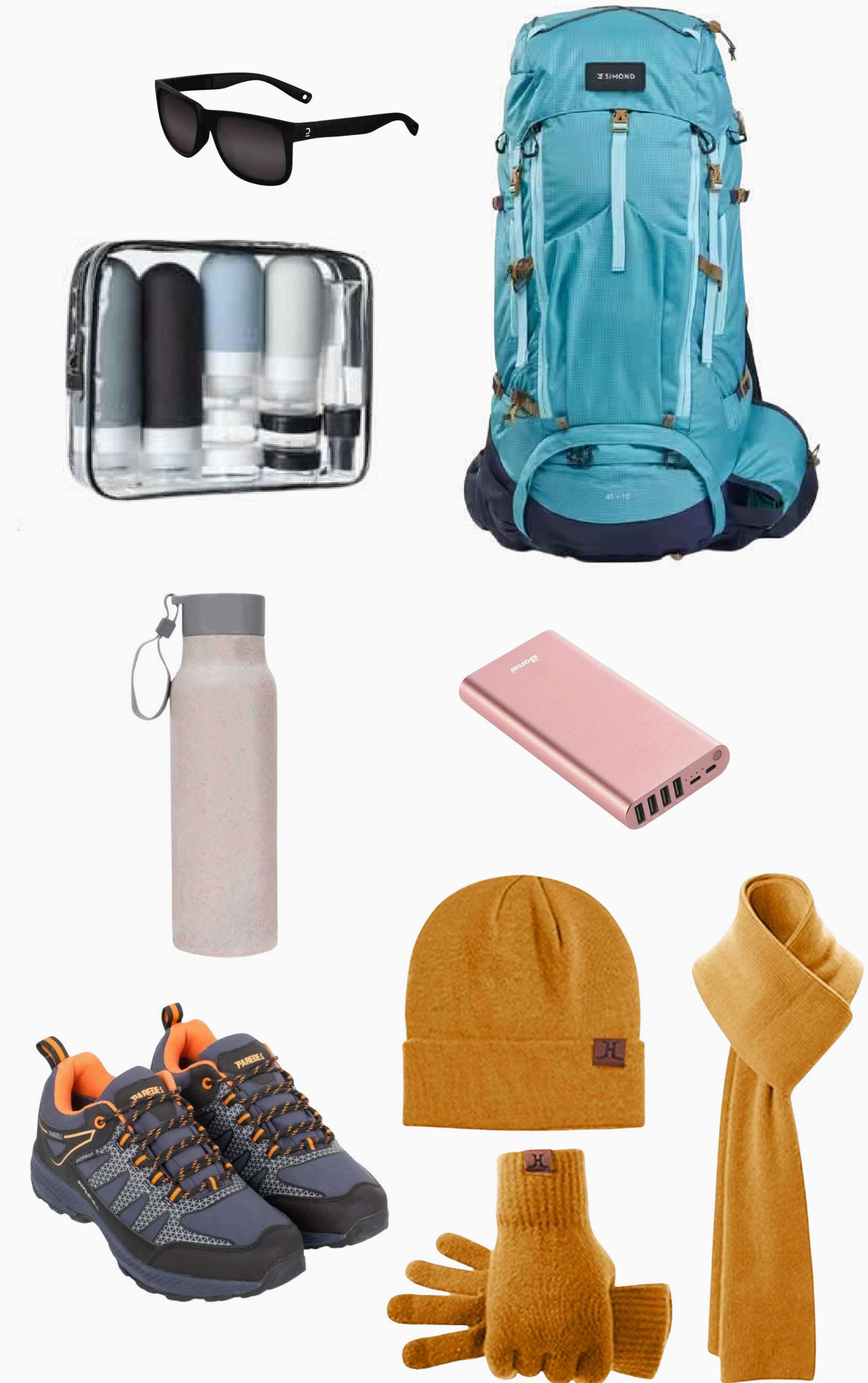

➤ WHAT SHOULD I BRING FOR THE AMAZON RAINFOREST EXPERIENCE (PUERTO MALDONADO)?

Lightweight, long-sleeved clothing, a rain jacket, insect repellent, sunscreen, a headlamp, a hat, closed-toe shoes, and a reusable water bottle are recommended. The lodge provides rubber boots and a poncho for excursions.
